Post Offices can relocate, close or new outlets can open. When changes happen or are being proposed it is important that the Post Office lets you know what is happening and why.

Changes to your local Post Office

We advocate on your behalf, and make sure the consumer voice in Northern Ireland is heard when a Post Office is potentially closing or moving.

Post Office's have a duty to you, its customers, to let you know about any changes in your local area and ask for your opinion.
